

## EU Settlement Scheme

Citizens Advice South Lincolnshire is managing the EU Settlement Scheme project and can provide support to EU, EEA and Swiss Citizens living in North Lincolnshire.

There are now less than six months to apply to the scheme and EU, EEA and Swiss citizens will lose their rights to live, work, access the NHS, if they don't apply by the 30 June 2021. Most citizens can apply at [gov.uk/eu-settled-status](https://gov.uk/eu-settled-status) but for those who are vulnerable or have other questions or issues, free and confidential support is available through our EUSS Support Team at Citizens Advice South Lincolnshire.

The project is funded by the Home Office. The service offers access to free immigration advice and support for vulnerable EU Citizens to apply for settled or pre-settled status in the UK and protect their rights after June 30 2021.

### **Vulnerable citizens may include:**

- Victims of domestic violence
- Victims of modern slavery and human trafficking
- Children and young people living in care
- Disabled/seriously ill people
- Residents in care homes
- Homeless people
