Members requested a pre-season meeting be arranged with the contractors and the Town Clerk as soon as possible to discuss this year's maintenance and additional preparation work for extra wild flower planting at the following locations Bridge before going into the Tesco Roundabout Park View Grassed area in front of 2 and 4 Ramsden Avenue Tofts Road/Stivvy Hill Flowering Lawn Mix for the corner of Pasture Road and Falklands Way

Also Picnic area on Barrow Road could have some woodland mix and woodland bulbs.
